

Document translation and verification Supporting documentation

Supporting documentation for translation and/or verification of documents

- A clear photocopy or scanned copy of your document(s) submitted for translation and/or verification (photographs of your document/documents will not be accepted).
 Exemptions that require submission of the original document by courier:

 (i) language certificates issued by recognised UK examination bodies
 (ii) qualifications issued by UK higher education institutions to be submitted to the
 - (ii) qualifications issued by UK higher education institutions to be submitted to the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office in the UK for legalisation purposes (Apostille).
- 2. A signed copy of our Request Form (PDF, 111 kb).
- 3. If the documents will not be received by the document holder in person, please also indicate the name and details of the authorised recipient on the Request Form.
- 4. A clear copy of the document holder's **identity card/passport/driver's license** or other official identification document.
- 5. If you submit a document issued by a UK institution, a signed copy of our **Consent** Form (PDF, 56 kb).
- 6. If you have had the same document(s) translated/verified by the British Council in the past, photocopies or scanned copies of the translation/verification.
- 7. **Only** if you intend to submit documents verified by the British Council to the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office (FCDO) for legalisation purposes (Apostille) and therefore need the original documents to be stamped (degree certificates are stamped overleaf), a signed copy of our **Consent to Stamp Original Documents Form** (PDF, 22 kb).

Supporting documentation for the issue of a British Council Statement for destroyed/lost University of Cambridge English language certificates

- A completed and signed copy of our <u>British Council Statement Form</u> (PDF, 146 kb).
